What has changed?

STEP 1b—From Monday 29th March

Another small, but important step means tenants can meet five other tenants (or other people) in the garden (or other outdoor public space, or a private garden) to socialise. We hope to erect the Gazebo again shortly. You should continue to observe 2m/6ft social distancing.

The general requirement to stay at home is also lifted, but you should still only travel locally.

There is no change regarding meeting indoors—the only people who should enter your flat at the moment are people providing you with care (includes personal care and domestic help) or carrying out necessary repair work.
