

# FIRST STEP on the Government's 'roadmap' out of lockdown

## What has changed?

### STEP 1a—From Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March

A small but important first step means tenants can meet one other tenant (or another person) in the garden (or other outdoor public space) to socialise, not just for exercise. You should continue to observe 2m/6ft social distancing.

Although Care Home residents can now nominate a single family member or friend for regular visits inside (under controlled conditions, where the visitor is tested for Covid and wears a face mask, gloves and an apron), this doesn't apply to Gatesfield (as it is not a Care Home). The only people who should enter your flat at the moment are people providing you with care (includes personal care and domestic help) or carrying out necessary repair work.

## What's the Next Step?

### STEP 1b—Expected to be from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> March
