The Gatesbield Development Fund

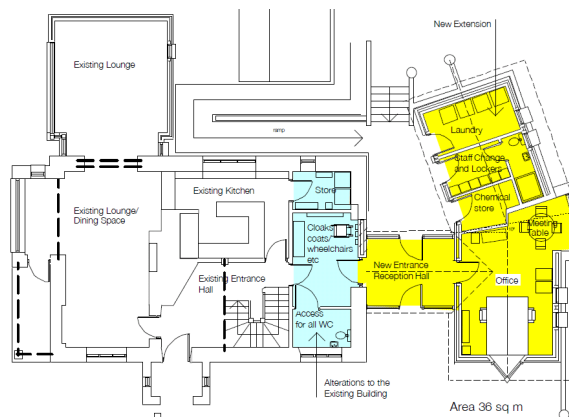
The Gatesbield Development Fund supports the development of property by Gatesbield to enhance the facilities offered to our tenants and to ensure that we continue to meet their changing needs. We are starting with our 'Improving Access' project, which we believe will bring great benefits to our tenants and the wider community who use our facilities.

The 'Improving Access' project

The 'Improving Access' project aims to extend and redevelop the communal facilities at Gatesbield, to enhance participation and enjoyment of our services. It will benefit tenants, visitors attending through our community outreach activities and those attending Windermere Quaker Meeting.

Our key priorities now are:

- ◆ **New accessible toilet facilities**
- ◆ **More handrails and a new ramp to a spacious entrance/reception hall**
- ◆ **Well lit and easier circulation routes inside with space for mobility aids**
- ◆ **Improved office, meeting, laundry and catering spaces.**
- ◆ **Accessible parking bay/level dropping-off point**



We have well-developed plans, which are available to view at Gatesbield. Our aim is to build sustainably and create a more inclusive and welcoming interior, retaining key features from the past and respecting the character and style of the building.
